Dangote Petroleum Refinery and Petrochemicals has secured US\$2.5 billion in new investment to finance the expansion of its Lagos refinery, marking one of Africa's largest publicly disclosed private equity investments.

The financing, backed by the Africa Finance Corporation (AFC) and an investment vehicle facilitated by the African Export-Import Bank (Afreximbank), will support the refinery's expansion programme and strengthen domestic refining and petrochemical capacity across the continent.

Malawi has officially launched its first utility-scale battery energy storage system, marking an important step toward strengthening the country's electricity network and expanding the use of clean energy. The 20-megawatt, 40-megawatt-hour battery facility is located in Kanengo, Lilongwe, and was developed through a partnership between the Electricity Supply Corporation of Malawi and the Global Energy Alliance for People and Planet.

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
